## Do you recycle?

Do you know the importance of recycling and why we should all do our part to take action?

Well, if you don't, here are a couple of fun facts....

- Did you know that by **recycling you can make \$\$ money?** "How?" You ask? Well it's quite simple you see, pretty much everything you see can be recycled; Aluminum, Copper, Brass, Stainless, Copper wire, Aluminum wheels, Radiators, Car Batteries, Scrap Iron and Tin to name a few. By recycling these items and taking those to your nearest recycling center you can get money back.
- Did you know you can also get money back by recycling your California Redemption Value (CRV) bottles and cans- Plastic, Glass, and Aluminum.
- Did you know that two hundred million gallons of used oil are improperly disposed of each year?
- Did you know that recycling just 2 gallons of used oil can generate enough electricity to run the average household for almost 24 hours? (Source: American Petroleum Institute)
- Did you know that it takes 42 gallons of crude oil, but only 1 gallon of used oil, to produce 2.5 quarts of new, high-quality lubricating oil?

Now, I bet you didn't know that! Now did you?

## Now where can I get \$ for my recycling?

### Drop Off- CRV Buy Back Locations

What is CRV? CRV refers to the State fee placed on certain BEVERAGE containers refunded when the containers are recycled. CRV values are set by state law. CRV items include Glass Bottles (CRV designated). Aluminum Cans, Bi-Metal Cans, Plastic Bottles (CRV designated).
