# Wastes Banned From The Trash



## Lights, Batteries & Electronics

- \*Fluorescent bulbs
- \*Batteries
- \*Computer & television monitors
- \*Electronic devices

## Mercury-Containing Items

- Electrical switches & relays
- Mercury thermostats
- Pilot light sensors
- Mercury gauges
- Mercury thermometers

## Household & Landscape Chemicals

- Flammables & poisons
- Acids, oxidizers, and bases
- Insecticides, herbicides, and fertilizers

## Paints & Solvents

- \*Latex paint
- \*Oil-based paint
- Nonempty aerosol paint or solvent cans
- Solvents

## Building Materials

- Asbestos
- \*Treated wood

## Automobile-Related

- Antifreeze
- \*Car Batteries
- \*Motor oil & filters
- \*Tires

## Other

- Compressed gas cylinders
- \*Needles & sharps
- PCB-containing materials
- Photo waste
- Nonempty aerosol cans that contain hazardous materials

▪ Prescription medications
