ADDENDUM NO. 1

The purpose of this Addendum is to modify the Contract Documents for the Annual Percolation Pond Rehabilitation Project 2020 (“Project”).

THE FOLLOWING ITEMS REFER TO THE CONTRACT DOCUMENTS AND TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS:

Item 1. Section 1 of the Notice Inviting Bids is revised to read as follows, with deleted text in strikethrough and added text underlined:

1. **Bid Submission.** The City of Fortuna (“City”) will accept sealed electronically submitted bids for its Annual Percolation Pond Rehabilitation Project 2020 (“Project”), by or before April 10 2020, at 11:00 a.m., via email in the manner set forth in Section 1 of the Instructions to Bidders, at its City Hall office, located at 621 11th Street, Fortuna California, at which time the bids will be publicly opened and the results will be posted on the City’s website at: <https://friendlyfortuna.com/CivicAlerts.aspx?CID=6>. ~~read aloud.~~

Item 2. Section 1 of the Instructions to Bidders is revised to read as follows, with deleted text in strikethrough and added text underlined:

1. Bid Submission.

- ~~1.1~~ **General.** Each Bid Proposal must be signed, sealed and submitted to City, using the form provided in the Contract Documents, by or before the date and time set forth in Section 1 of the Notice Inviting Bids, or as amended by subsequent addendum, via email to kcarter@ci.fortuna.ca.us. The Bid Proposal and all required forms and attachments must be included in the email as PDF scanned attachments. The subject line of the email must include the Project title and bidder’s registration number with the California Department of Industrial Relations (“DIR”) for bidding on public works contracts (Labor Code §§ 1725.5 and 1771.1), as follows:

~~Faxed or emailed Bid Proposals will not be accepted, unless otherwise specified. City will provide an electronic read receipt to each bidder showing the date and time the submission was received. Late submissions will not be considered, be returned unopened.~~ City reserves the right to postpone the date or time for receiving or opening bids. Each bidder is solely responsible for all of its costs to prepare and submit its bid and by submitting a bid waives any right to recover those costs from City. The bid price(s) must include all costs to

perform the Work as specified, including all labor, material, supplies, and equipment and all other direct or indirect costs such as applicable taxes, insurance and overhead.
